Clerk & Recorder's Office: Resolution 2022-016, Approval of the 2022 Proposed Precinct Changes; In accordance with C.R.S. 1-5-101 and 1-5-103, changes in the boundaries of precincts or the creation of new precincts for partisan elections must be completed no later than twenty-nine days prior to the first Tuesday in March after the Census data is released. The County Clerk and Recorder proposes changes to Boulder County precincts and boundaries, which have been created in alignment with the approved redistricting maps from the independent commissions, using the 2020 Decennial Census information.

The County Clerk and Recorder has also taken into consideration active voter counts, as required by law. The Clerk and Recorder requests that the Board of County Commissioners adopt the proposed precincts and boundaries described in the provided documents.

RESOLUTION 2022-016

APPROVING PROPOSED 2022 PRECINCT CHANGES

WHEREAS, The Boulder County Clerk and Recorder (“Clerk”) has requested that the Board of County Commissioners (“BOCC”) approve certain precinct changes for 2022; and,

WHEREAS, if the Colorado Supreme Court approves the technical corrections (split parcels, CD2 and CD7 boundary change) submitted by the Clerk, the BOCC authorizes the Clerk to implement the requested technical corrections; and,

WHEREAS, Colorado Revised Statute (“C.R.S.”) §1-5-101 provides that, subject to approval by the BOCC, the Clerk shall divide the county into as many election precincts for all general, primary, and congressional vacancy elections as is convenient for the eligible electors of the county and shall designate the place for each precinct at which elections are to be held; and,

WHEREAS, C.R.S. §1-5-103 requires that changes in the boundaries of precincts or the creation of new precincts for partisan elections must be completed no later than twenty-nine days prior to the first Tuesday in March; and,

WHEREAS, the requested changes are fully set forth in the meeting documents hereto and incorporated herein by this reference. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners, County of Boulder, State of Colorado, that the precinct changes as requested by the Boulder County Clerk and Recorder which are attached hereto are hereby accepted and approved.

Redistricting

- Redistricting Commissions established in 2018 (Amendments Y, Z) to draw congressional and state legislative districts

2021

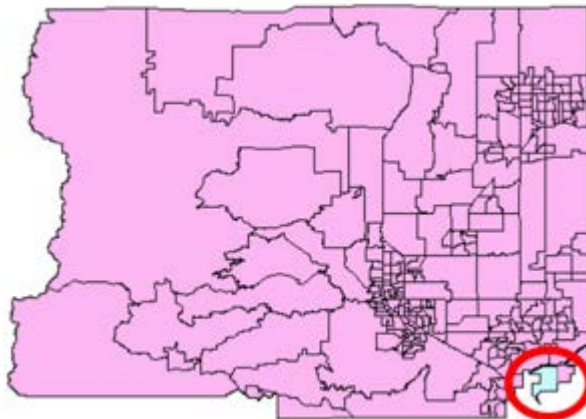
- Census delays changed the timelines
- Independent Redistricting Commissions completed their work using the 2020 Decennial Census information
- December - CO Supreme Court approves the commission maps

Reprecincting

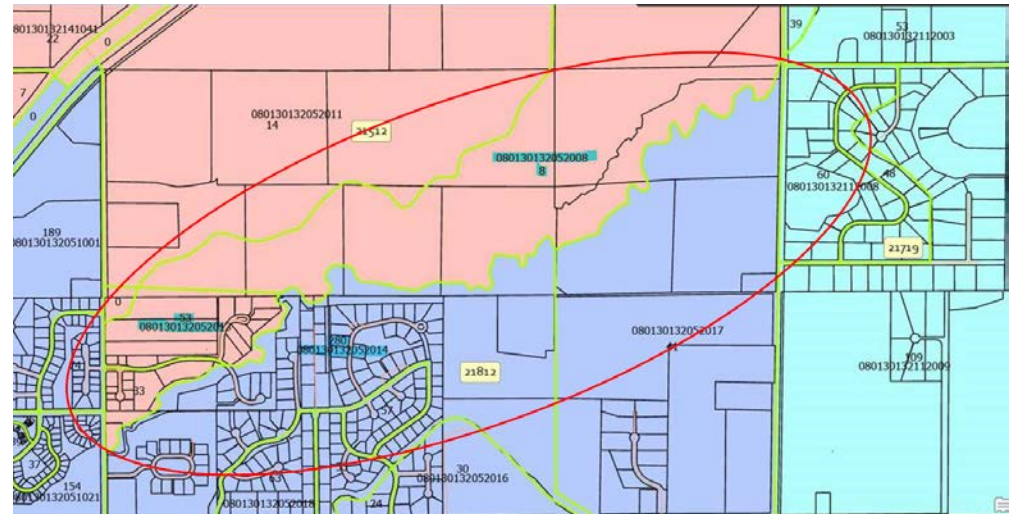
December 2021

- Implement changes to comply with the court approved commission maps
- Identified a few technical corrections (split parcels, CD7 voter privacy); sent change requests to SOS
- Analyzed boundaries and identified required geography changes
- Analyzed precinct voter counts and identified precincts to combine

Reprecincting - continued

January 2022

- Precinct edits

- ✓ Edit geography if precinct contained >1 combination of Congressional, House or Senate districts
- ✓ Decreased number of precincts (went from 240 to 194)
- ✓ Confirmed precinct active voter count is <2,000
- ✓ Kept current precinct numbering scheme; renumber precincts to avoid gaps
- ✓ Assigned placeholder precinct numbers to areas pending court decision, or with no population or voters, or with very low voter counts (001-004)

- Clerk's Office to implement approved changes
 - ✓ Update statewide voter registration database (SCORE) to reflect changes
 - ✓ Notify SOS when implementation is complete
 - ✓ Deadline to complete implementation is January 31, 2022 (C.R.S. 1-5-103(1))
