

Request for approval and signature of the report for the 2022 Impact Assistance Grants from Colorado Parks and Wildlife Service:

In any county in which the Division of Parks and Wildlife owns property, the board of county commissioners certifies once a year during the regular tax assessment period to the parks and wildlife commission the current dollar amount representing the negative financial impact which such ownership has on the county's finances by considering the factors listed in §§ 30-25-302(1)(a)(I), (II), and (III), C.R.S., and the finances of any political subdivision which lies within such county.

The Assessor's Office provides a report of valuation and tax information to the County Commissioners, requesting their review and signature. Once approved by the county Commissioners the parks and wildlife commission then reviews those dollar amounts and certifies those amounts to the general assembly. The general assembly may then make an appropriation in the form of an impact assistance grant to the county upon such certification, §§ 30-25-301 and 302, C.R.S.
