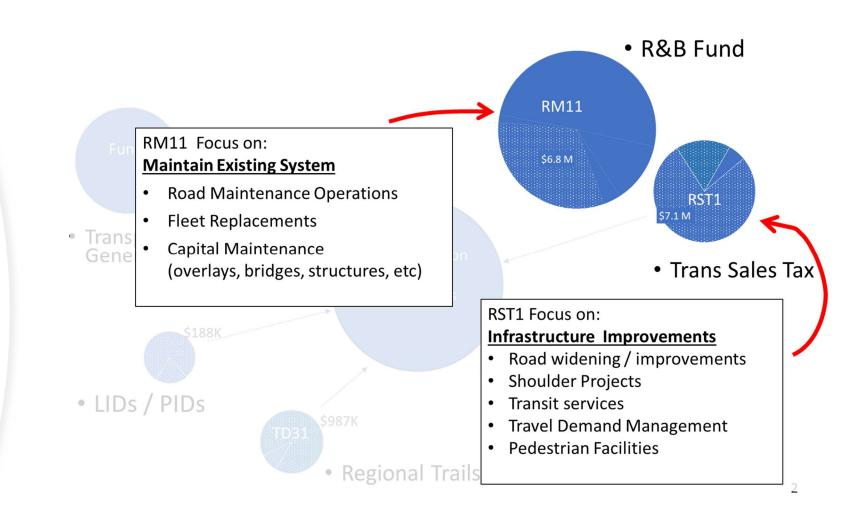
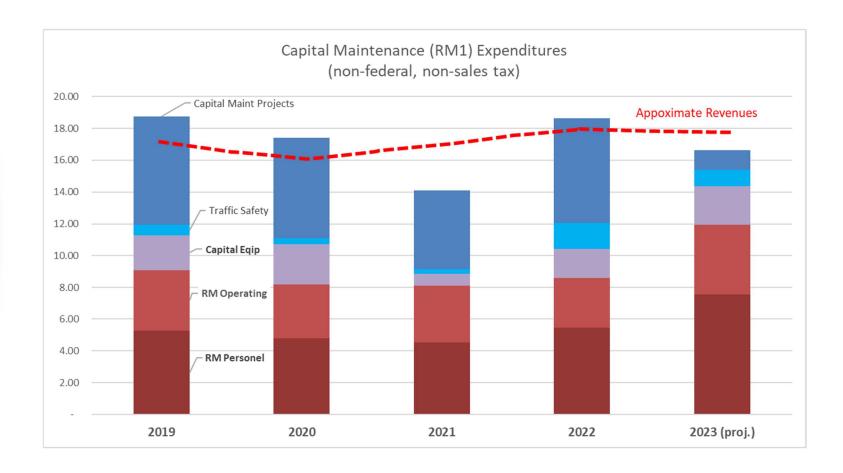
## Transportation Funding

- Road and Bridge Fund consists of two primary Appropriations
  - 1. Road and Bridge Maintenance Fund (RM11)
  - 2. Road & Transit Sales Tax (RST)
- Each have their own function but exist in the same fund.
- Today's focus is on RM11



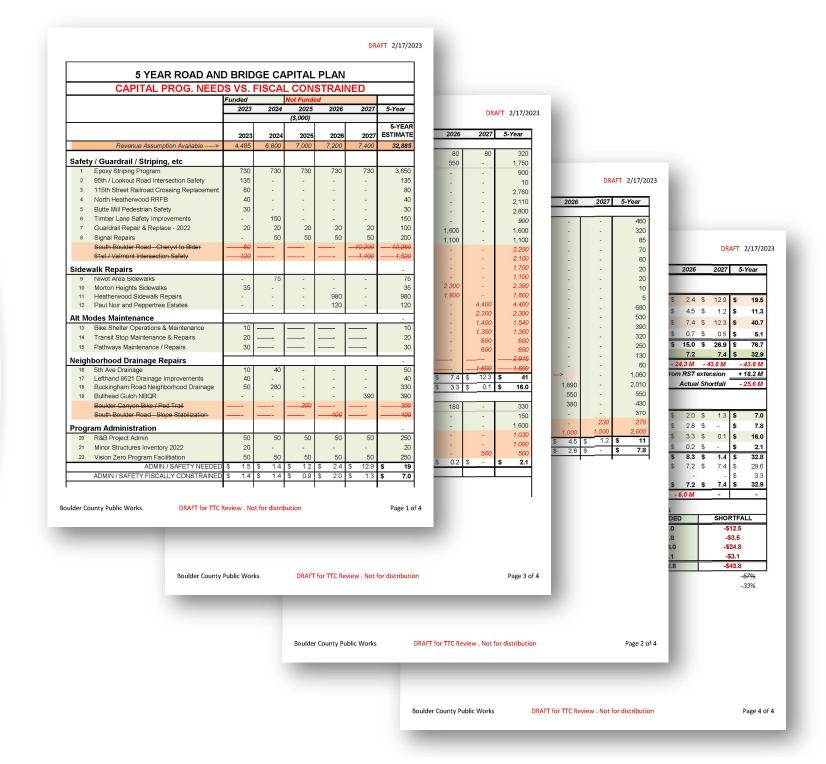
# Maintenance Fund (RM11)

- County spends average of \$17.1 M per year
- Includes road maintenance, capital equip, traffic safety and capital maintenance projects.



### Capital Maintenance Five-Year Plan

- Current five-year plan for capital maintenance projects \$77 million needed over the next five-years.
  - \$20M for traffic safety
  - \$11M for bridges & structures
  - \$41M for road resurfacing.
  - \$5M for subdivision collector roads.



#### Five-Year Plan

- Assumes \$33M in funding available for capital maintenance, equivalent to \$6.6M per year, based on past year funding levels.
- This funding plan results in a \$44M deficit over a 5-year timeframe.
- The sales tax extension addresses \$18M of that need, reducing the overall shortfall to \$26 M.

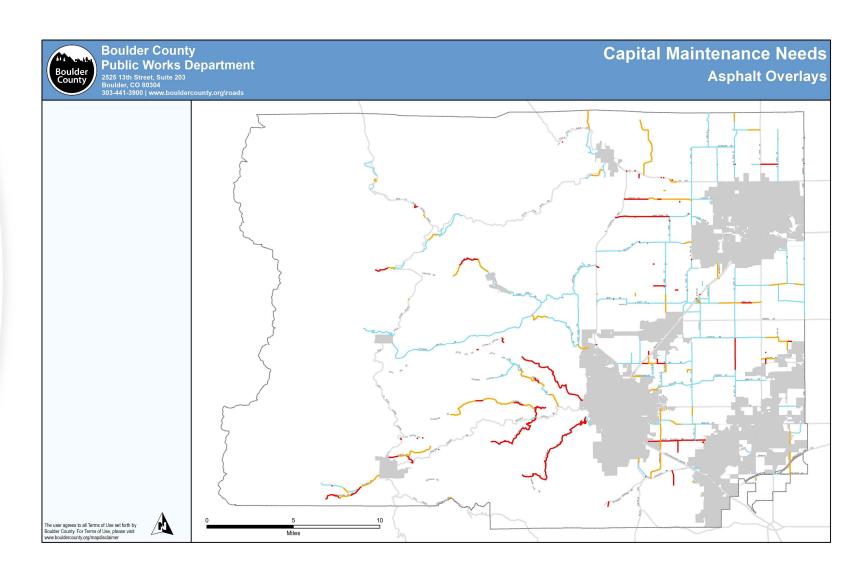
## Bridges & Structures

- County has replaced 86 bridges and structures over past ten years. Boulder County maintains 495 major/minor structures and 8,500 culverts.
- Close to 90 percent of that cost was covered by flood recovery.
- Seven bridges currently need repairs, and eleven minor structures need replacement.



### Asphalt Overlays

- Current Pavement Quality Index for Primary Network is 73. Goal is 70 or above.
- 80 miles of the 400-miles of paved roads have been resurfaced in the last 10 years.
- 78 miles of primary network roads in fair/poor condition and in need of treatment.



## FY23 Capital Maintenance Focus

- Three road overlays Hygiene Road, 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave Niwot, Reserve Drive. Cost: \$930K
- Two structure replacements Riverside at Cave Creek and 51<sup>st</sup> at Dry Creek #2. Cost: \$980k
- One bridge repair 119<sup>th</sup> over St Vrain Creek. Cost:\$445k
- Total cost: **\$2,355M**
