# 1. Policy Council Updates

• All Policy Council members have gone through a Head Start governance training. Training was provided in English and Spanish. Policy Council meetings will be help the 2<sup>nd</sup> Monday of each month from 5-7pm. The program has contracted an in-person translation company to provide simultaneous translation to members that need it. Dinner and childcare will be provided, as well as a \$25 gift card to each member who attends. There are currently 12 current Head Start parent members representing every site and 1 community member.

### 2. Equity Work

• At our first Professional Development Day we introduced the concept of Place/Name/Intention and how we wanted to introduce ourselves by saying who we are, not what we do. We had the everyone go around and do this since we have new staff and it was a nice way to bring everyone together in the morning. I asked staff to think about their identities and how they bring all of that into the classroom. Children and families bring their own identities and history also. Remembering that, helps us to build the community necessary for a successful program.

Sunflower School (Boulder): 46% (1 late drop & a transfer)





• September 2023 Enrollment: 99








BCHS Cost for Meals: \$2,259.61
