## **RESOLUTION N2023-4**

A RESOLUTION SUMMARIZING EXPENDITURES AND REVENUES FOR AND ADOPTING A BUDGET FOR THE NEDERLAND ECOPASS PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT, FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR BEGINNING THE FIRST DAY OF JANUARY 2024, AND ENDING THE LAST DAY OF DECEMBER 2024.
