A RESOLUTION SUMMARIZING EXPENDITURES AND REVENUES FOR EACH FUND ADOPTING A BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF BOULDER, COLORADO, FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR BEGINNING THE FIRST DAY OF JANUARY 2024 AND ENDING THE LAST DAY OF DECEMBER 2024.
