

RESOLUTION NO. N2024-1

A RESOLUTION LEVYING GENERAL PROPERTY TAXES FOR THE YEAR 2023 TO HELP DEFRAY THE COSTS OF GOVERNMENT FOR THE NEDERLAND ECO PASS PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT FOR THE 2024 BUDGET YEAR.

WHEREAS, the Board of the Nederland Eco Pass Public Improvement District (“Board”) has adopted the annual budget in accordance with the Local Government Budget Law, on December 5th, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the amount of money required for the Nederland Eco Pass program and other authorized needs of the Boulder County Nederland Eco Pass Public Improvement District (“District”), is as follows:

WHEREAS, the 2023 valuation for assessment for the District, as certified by the County Assessor on December 13, 2023 is \$116,152,782; and

WHEREAS, after reviewing the requirements for anticipated expenditures as well as anticipated revenues from other sources for 2024, the Board has determined that for the year of 2024 valuations, the proper mill levy, which shall be collected in 2024 by the Treasurer of the County of Boulder, State of Colorado, upon each dollar of the assessed valuation of all taxable property within the District, shall be 1.850 mills, as approved by the voters of the District.

The mill levy shall be distributed as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That for the purpose of meeting general operating expenses of the District during the 2024 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 1.850 mills, upon each dollar of the total valuation for assessment of all taxable property within the District for the year 2023.
